# Junior Show & Tell Program (JST)

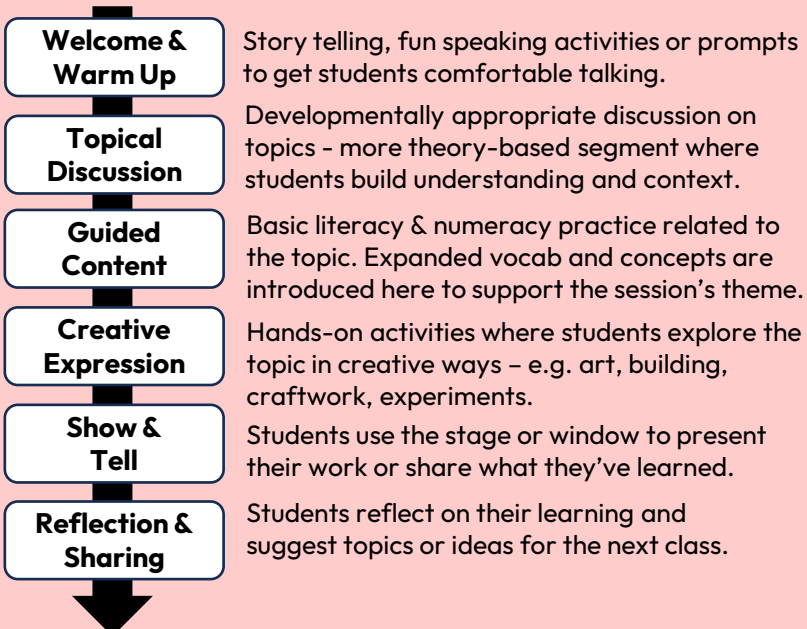
## Nurturing confident young speakers through curiosity, storytelling and sharing
